- To embrace and celebrate every child's uniqueness.
- To treat all children and their families equitably and with respect.
- To include and support every child, of all ethnic backgrounds, cultures, languages, genders, socio-economic backgrounds, and/or varied abilities.
- To make all possible modifications or adaptations to ensure that every child is able to participate in activities.
- To ensure all Individual Program Plans are chronologically or developmentally age appropriate.
- To consult and work with external professionals who offer their expertise in a variety of disciplines who work as a team to support children (e.g. speech therapists, early interventionists, etc.)
